Although the construction of the road has still to be determined, it is clear that our campaign which started in 2008 was successful in drawing the attention of the media and many people to our situation. We are very grateful to everyone who has supported our campaign and written letters to those in authority etc.

The current position of the Group is that we are continuing to discuss our position with EMDA and the local planning authorities. Due to the current economic situation and the change of Government, the road has for now been put on hold. In the longer-term it is likely to go ahead, however 3W will do everything within its powers to protect our interests and preserve Scouting facilities for young people.

It may not be possible to prevent the building of the GAR (Gedling Access Road) but our primary objectives remain to ensure that the integrity of the Pepperpots site is retained for the benefit of all members of Scouting and Guiding in the locality and that 3W will remain and prosper as a vibrant Scout Group to bring good Scouting to more young people.
